Executive Summary

Last February 20-21, 2015 and March 6-8, 2015 the Mountain Province State Polytechnic College with its collaboration with the Local Government of Sadanga as its partner in the implementation of the college's extension services conducted the Seminar-Workshop on Instructional Materials Development at Sadanga National High School and at Saclit National High School. A total of 26 out of 36 secondary school teachers have successfully completed the five-days training or a total 40 hours.

The resource speakers during the seminar workshop were Dr. Glynis K. Ngeteg from the Mountain Province General Comprehensive High School, Mr. Johnny P. Cayabas from the Liberal Arts Department, Mr. Keith Jimson Mang-usan and Mr. Jay Napanoy from the Teacher Education Department. The topics that were discussed during the seminar are as follows:

- a) Principles of Instructional Material Development
- b) Needs Analysis and Preparing Instructional Objectives
- c) Different Types of Instructional Materials

- d) Criteria for evaluating Instructional Materials
- e) Validation of Instructional Materials
- f) Copyrighting of the Developed IM

The participants were tasked to come up with an instructional material either a module or a workbook in their field of specialization. Dr. Susan A. Lopez, VPRDE, announced earlier that the participants will only be given their certificates upon submission of their outputs.

After days of preparation, the participants presented their developed instructional materials last March 7, 2015 at Saclit National High School. Dr. Annie Grail F. Ekid and Dr. Glynis K. Ngeteg from the TED and the Graduate School evaluated the outputs. Dr. Ekid further stated after the activity that the presented outputs are more advanced than what she expected. Instructional Materials in Mathematics were evaluated by Mr. Jay Napanoy and Mr. Keith Jimson Mang-usan.

The over-all assessment of the participants in the activity was very satisfactory with a computed mean of 4.21. They were able to gain knowledge during the activity; also, they were able to develop instructional objectives for their instructional materials and applied the forms and styles in their developed instructional materials. Also, the principals evaluated the activity during the meeting cum planning held at the conference hall last March 13, 2015 saying the activity was very satisfactory.

The awarding of certificates to the participants will be on April 6, 2015 at the college just after the seminar-workshop on Microsoft Office Publisher since the activity will be having the same participants.
