II. RATIONALE

Pursuant to "Prevention of Adolescent Pregnancy Act of 2018" where the policy of state shall Recognize, promote, and strengthen the role of adolescents and young people in the overall human and socioeconomic development of the country. Promote and protect the human rights of all individuals including the adolescents particularly in their rights to sexual and reproductive health.. the College through the Gender and Development System had organized and conducted series of activities; Gender and Health Awareness, Gender and Reproductive Health Seminar, Training and Workshop, Training of Technical Adviser for student GAD Resource Pool who were participated by the students coming from the different department of the College (TED, CRIM, BSA, BSOA, BSN, HRMT, IT, BSBA) as a respond of the College to the governments' call to prevent teen-age /adolescent pregnancy.

The conducted program covers the Gender and Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) the process of acquiring complete, accurate, relevant and age appropriate information and skills on all matters relating to the reproductive system, its functions and processes and human sexuality and forming attitudes and beliefs about sex, sexual identity, interpersonal relationship, affection, intimacy and gender roles. It has the purpose of developing skills of young people for them to make informed decisions such as the capacity to distinguish between facts and myths on sex and sexuality, and critically evaluate and discuss the moral, religious, social and cultural dimensions of related sensitive issues, such as contraception and abortion, rape resulting to pregnancy, and to decide to prevent risky behaviours that can undermine the realization of their aspirations and potentials. From this, Mountain Province State Polytechnic College (MPSPC) does not have an apathetic attitude towards these alarming problems, in fact through the GAD System it continually device programs to address these alarming issues through seminar and workshop, training, advocacy conducted in different high school in the province.

Statistic shows that from 2014 - 2017, Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) holds the highest rate of teen-age pregnancy where 3.5 percent of girls/women aged 15-19 or those at the beginning of the childbearing stage, have become pregnant and given birth. In Mountain province out of 3,024 cases, records shows that 358 recorded teen age pregnancy where Paracelis listed 90, Bontoc 47, Bauko 42. According to the Philippine National Authority (PNA) there are lot of factors, such as peer pressure, broken family, lack of parental guidance, and of course their

curiosity where teenagers wants to explore. In addition to this, in a research study conducted by MPSPC entitled "Teen age Pregnancy as Form of Delinquency among Criminology Student", by Depayso and Cruz (2018) rape is one factor of teen age pregnancy.

Anent to this, Certified Student GAD Resource Pool guided by the academe through its GAD System will conduct series of activities addressing the aforementioned national issue. Furthermore, this is also a perfect avenue for institutional marketing.

III. OBJECTIVES

This activity aims to;

- 1. extend technical assistance through the conduct series of seminar, workshop, training and orientation on the Prevention of teen age/adolescent pregnancy for Junior and senior high school; to ensure healthy lives and promote the wellbeing of girl/women.
- 2. achieve gender equality and empowerment to both girls/boys/women/men. Where boys, young men should also know their roles.
- 3. market the college, where the student GAD Resource Pool are perfect testimonies for the schools and its students.

At the end of the activity the following are attained:

- 1. as a learning institution we have taken the lead, ensured, developed and promoted the Comprehensive Sexual Education as mandated by law.

NARRATIVE REPORT II.

As result of the recently conducted training needs assessment on Gender and Development, the following topics were identified and addressed:

- 1. Gender and Human Sexuality
- 2. Gender and Reproductive Health (Teen Age Pregnancy, Premarital Sex and abortion.
- 3. Drug and Alcohol Abuse
- 4. Anti-Sexual Harassment
- 5. Love, Courtship and Dating

As an academe it is really necessary to take part in advocating and raising the awareness of young people on the different issues that they encounter, which also is becoming a national concern. Through the MPSPC GAD programs, the academe is actively able to raise the level of awareness of its different clientele. The following topics was distributed to the different trained student GAD Resource Pool.

In the morning the first participants were the Grades 11 and 12 (Senior High School). After the preliminaries, the first topic was discussed by Mr. Clay Mark Wagsey - a trained GAD Resource Pool. One thing that should be remembered in his discussion is on terminologies where; "GAY" is defined as a male having a sexual relationship with same male, therefore the word "GAY" should not be used to address someone who is a male and acts feminine, instead they should be called "FEMINE" on the other hand the term "LESBIAN" means a female who have a sexual relationship with a female, and again therefore no one can just call a female "LESBIAN" if they are not into a sexual relationship it they can be called "MASCULINE".

After the discussion on Gender and Sexuality, Mr. Keem Sumcad, an alumni and speaker discussed on the pitfalls of LOVE, DATING AND COURTSHIP. This is one teen issues among the young people today. Followed by Mr. Marval Bucaog- a student GAD Resource Pool discussed on Anti-Sexual Harassment and Drug Abuse. They were educated on forms of sexual harassment and how the law can protect them.

To officially close the program, Ms. Flordeliza G. Cruz thanked all the participants for spending their time listening to all the advocacies extended by the college.


