BPAT & OVERVIEW on BASIC LIFE SUPPORT as coordinated by the Bontoc LGU and Bontoc PNP.

Venue: BAYYO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Results/Action taken:

As coordinated by the Bontoc Municipal PNP and the Bontoc LGU thru the MDRRMO Mr. Feliciano Vergara and with permission to our MPSPC Bontoc Campus Executive Dean Dr. Eric Fulangen, we arrived at Bayyo Elementary School at exactly 8:15 am. Most of the participants are adult and some are young mothers with their siblings. The activity started with a prayer and followed by welcome message of the Barangay Captain of Bayyo emphasizing their experience during the Florida Bus Accident wherein they just scoop the victims from the ravine and run to the road. They realize their mistake when trained responder are already at the site managing by bandaging, packing and transporting the victims through spine board. The Bontoc Chief of Police Sir Challoy also delivered his short message.

The training proper started with the demonstration of using tri-angular bandage and elastic bandage and then to be followed by participants. Because of unlimited time we only demonstrate how to splint victim with their fracture and pack to the spine board. There is also a short question and answer with regards to emergency care, etc. and we go home to Bontoc at exactly 5:30 p.m. after a cup of coffee with the barangay Officials and participants.

Recommendations/Suggestion:

- The participants suggested if they could have another chance to attend a 3 days or 5 days training on Basic Life Support wherein we answered them to request to request Mayor Franklyn Odsey for this training or used their disaster budget for the said training in partnership with the Bontoc Emergency Response Team wherein materials will be provided by BERT.
