II. NARRATIVE REPORT

The activity on project result presentation cum farmers conference slated on December 17-18, 2019 was conducted earlier in barangay Anabel, Sadanga on December 10, 2019. This was requested by the farmers because most of them are involved of the provincial meet which was slated on December 15-19,2019. While in Monamon Sur, the activity was conducted as planned.

In barangay Anabel, a total of 30 farmers attended the activity. The farmer cooperators shared their experiences on the impact of the interventions that were introduced through the project. The S&T interventions that the farmers claimed which helped them mitigate the effect of climate change in their farms is the use of clean planting materials of sweet potato and compost, the water storage tank and the trainings conducted. Ms. Febia M. Copas testified that because of the portable tank she was able to survived her crops during the dry season because she was able to stored water to irrigate her crops. Another farmer in the name of Julie Omansan happily testified that the project encouraged her to participate on the activities conducted to the farmer cooperators because she was given opportunities not only to learn but to mingle with other farmers. Moreover, she was encouraged to plant camote because of the results she has observed at the demo farm. More farmers testified that the SAFE Project has helped them enhanced their knowledge and skills in mitigating the impact of climate change in their farms especially on the restoration of camote production in their locality. Ms. Isabel L. Walis, the farmer leader later expressed her gratitude to the implementing and funding agency as well. She further request a continues support of the college for the development of their farm produce.

In Monamon Sur, a total of 36 individual participated in the activity, 29 farmers cooperator, 3 barangay officials,1 teacher and 3 students. The same the farmer cooperator shared their experiences on the impact of the interventions that were introduced through the project. Ms. Cristina Moc-eng in her testimony mentioned that the portable drum motivated her to plant potato on the month of January 2019. During that time, the weather is drier as compared to 2018 on the same month. The drums served as storage for water that is pumped from a small creek found 100 meters below her farm. Mr. Efren Loogan and Basilio Ballo the farmer leader on their part are not convinced on the use of bio-compost but when they use MPSP-bio- compost consecutively for two year, they notice that crops planted in area applied with compost are greener, less damage by pest and more tolerant than plants planted in areas not applied with compost. They then conclude that effects of compost in farm is not observed immediately like the effect of commercial fertilizer.


